- 3 & 4) Through this Petition, the Petitioner has impugned Repatriation Order dated 28.10.2022 whereby, the Petitioner an employee of Karachi Development Authority working in Malir Development Authority has been repatriated and stands released.

Learned Counsel for the Petitioner submits that the repatriation issue of the Petitioner and similarly placed employees has been resolved after litigation up to the Hon'ble Supreme Court and time and again orders have been passed whereafter Notification was issued in compliance of such orders. However, per learned Counsel, notwithstanding this, the Director General Malir Development Authority has once again issued the impugned repatriation order. He further submits that in respect of another employee in some what similar facts and circumstances, this Court on 28.10.2022 in C. P. No. D-6623/2022 has passed ad-interim orders against the repatriation of the said Petitioner. He has referred to such order available at Page 169 of the file.

Let notice be issued to the Respondents as well as Advocate General Sindh for 21.12.2022. Till then, the impugned Repatriation Order dated 28.10.2022 available at Page 149 of the file shall remain suspended.
