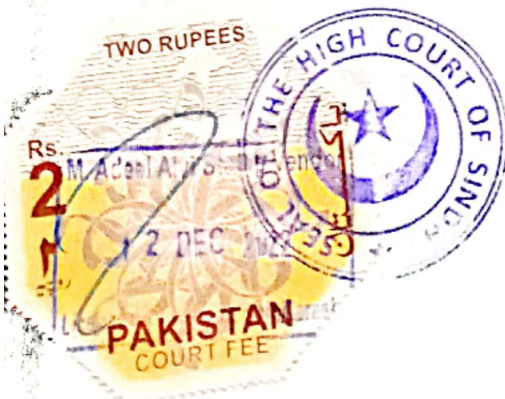

1. Urgency granted.
2. Exemption granted subject to all just exceptions.

3&4. Learned counsel for the petitioner states that he has already filed an appeal before the Tribunal and subsequently filed stay application, but the Tribunal is neither taking up the appeal nor the stay application. He states that he would be satisfied and would not press this petition if directions are issued to the Tribunal to take up the stay application, if not appealed and decide the same within shortest possible time. Mr. G.M Bhutto, learned Assistant Attorney General present in Court waives and has no objection for disposal of this petition on the said prayer made by the learned counsel appearing for the petitioner.

We therefore dispose of this petition as not pressed, however, direct the Chairman, Appellate Tribunal Inland Revenue to take up the stay application, if not appealed and decide the same preferably within a period of 15 days' time from the date of receipt of this order. Till such time, the Department would proceed in accordance with law and not to enforce any recovery.

With these directions the instant petition alongwith pending application(s) stands disposed of.
